

3.03(B) MEMBERSHIP FEES IN ARREARS

Issue/Background:

In 2015, the College fiscal year changed in anticipation of a merger with CAPF. Several bylaws are dependent on the fiscal year including the effects on membership payment and arrear accounts. Upon reviewing the bylaws under Article 3 Memberships, 3.03B. Membership Fees in Arrears, Council has agreed that this article must be changed to reflect the fiscal year change and its influence on unpaid accounts. The new fiscal year begins July 1st as compared to the previous start of January 1st; therefore, arrear accounts must be paid by July 1st. Council further contends that the cancellation bylaw allowing 60 days to pass on an arrear account is too lenient.

- Whereas ... the “College” is committed to good governance.
- Whereas ... the “College” has a new fiscal year and has bylaws influenced by the fiscal year.
- Whereas ... the “College” must align all bylaws to recognize the new fiscal year.
- This special resolution is an amendment to the bylaw and requires a vote of 2/3 of the voting members to be changed

The existing wording of article 3 Membership, 3.03 Membership Fees in Arrears is as follows:

3.03 MEMBERSHIP FEES IN ARREARS

B. IF ANY MEMBER IS IN ARREARS FOR FEES OR ASSESSMENTS AS OF MARCH 1 OF THE MEMBERSHIP YEAR, THAT MEMBER SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BE CANCELLED. (RESOLUTION 2004-12)(DELETED RESOLUTION 2008-05)
