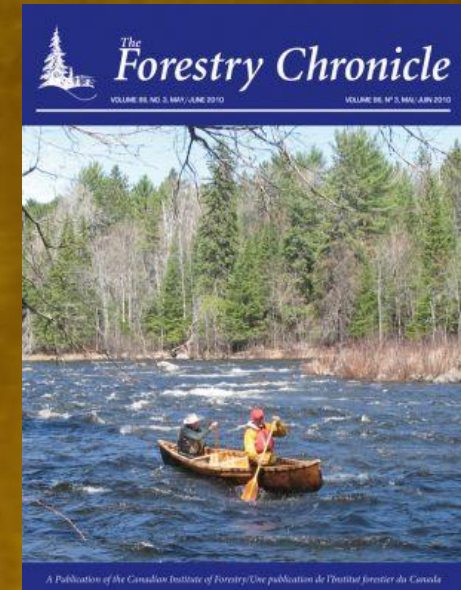

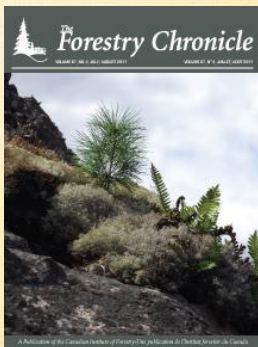

Professional paper:

Essays that report on a program of work, describe a position on an issue, or present a case for a point of view in the area of forestry (e.g., conference proceedings/presentations).

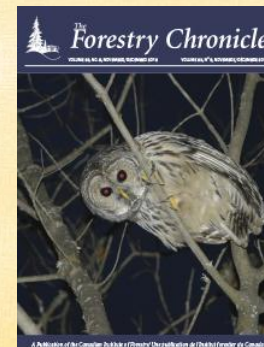
TYPES OF PAPERS

Scientific/Technical paper:

Articles that present forest research results or an analytical literature review on a scientific or **technical subject**. Scientific papers are original and previously unpublished papers. Scientific papers are peer-reviewed.

Notes:

Short communications that report important findings, usually a completed project of smaller scope. Not used for preliminary publication or as a progress report.
